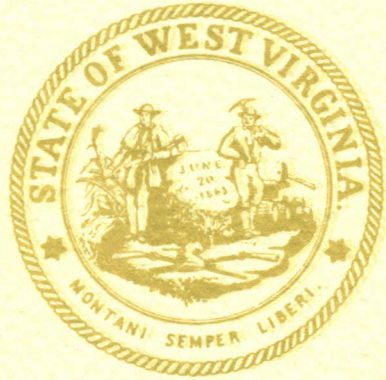

Industrial Technology	Orange
Social Work	Citron
Associate Degrees	White
